INDEPENDENCE DAY




Janmashtami Celebration

Whatever they learn is forgotten as soon as they finish their exams. To improve the learning process and to retain what has been learnt, independent learning is an important factor. Independent or self-directed learning is an important skill which a child should acquire to improve one's learning. What is independent Independent learning is when a child becomes autonomous and is less dependent on teachers for their support in learning. In other words, a child is dependent on himself for finding facts and doing research work instead of relying on the teacher for supplying information. Independent learning prepares a student not just for education but for the life ahead. Once achieved, it will make students excel in their work areas. Independence in learning leads to motivation, independence, time management, multi-tasking, strong reading and writing skillsWhile undertaking self study a student should study with keen interest and full concentration, noticing all the new words and their spellings.
