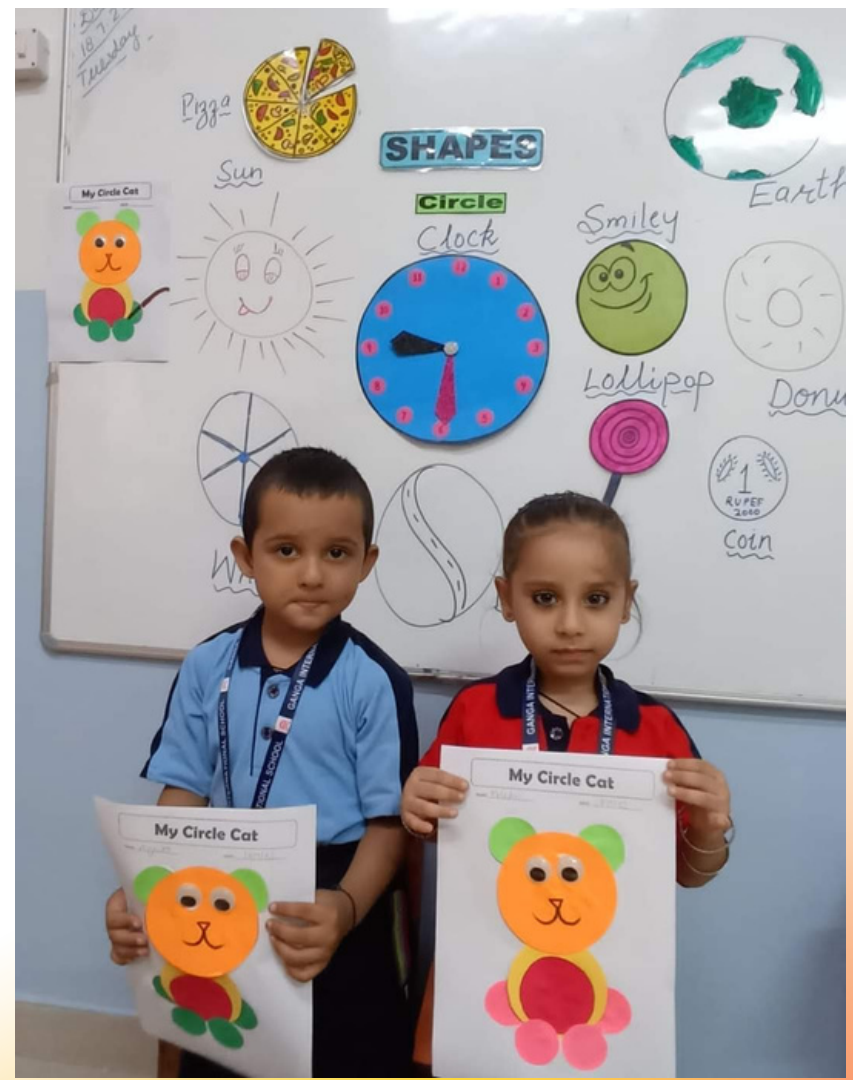

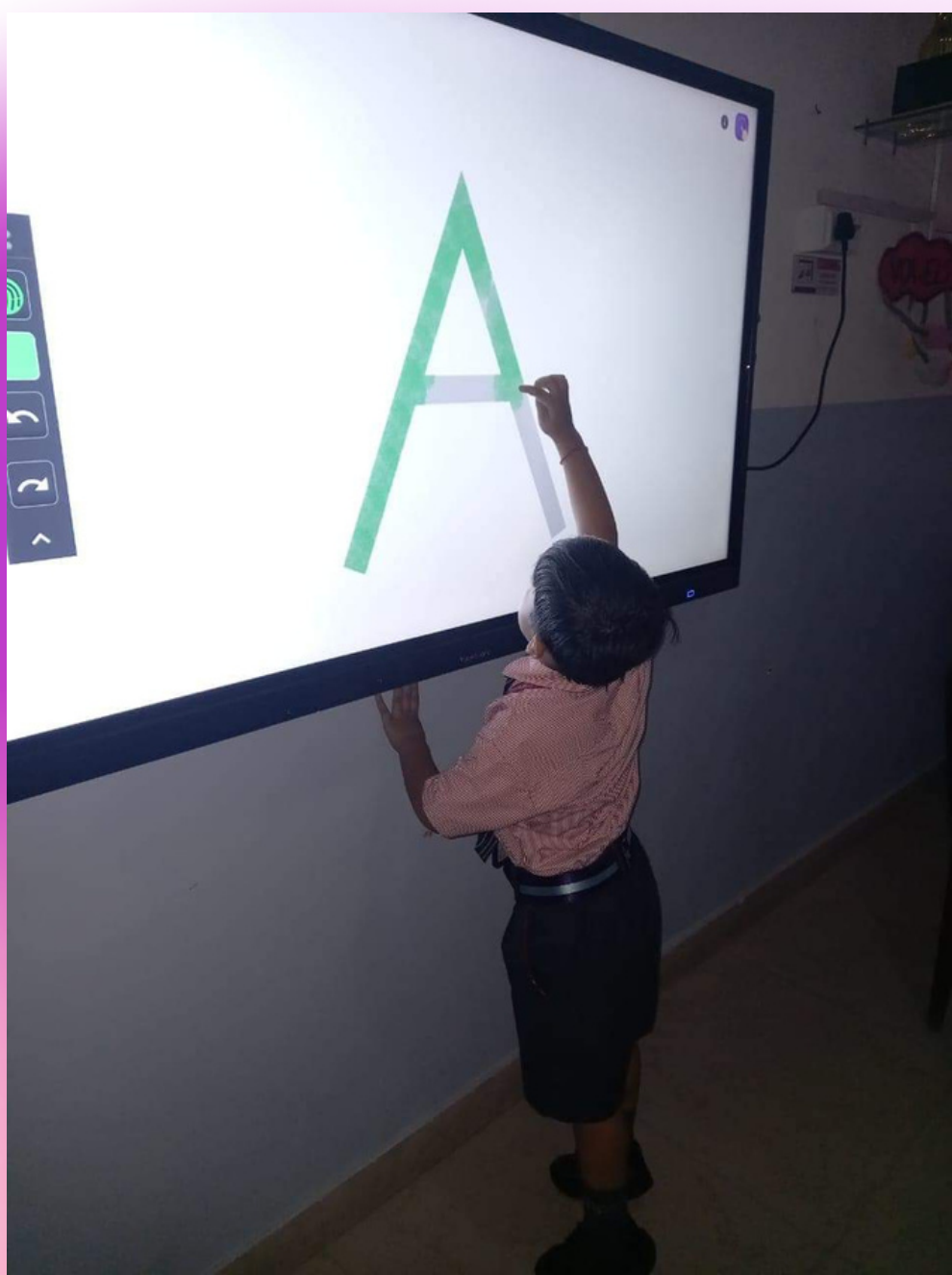




Enabling Classrooms with Digital Space
